1. The tender is for appointment of Region wise Ad contractors for display of ads in the covered area (within the built up area) of bus stations of KRMR REGION for a period of five years.
2. e-procurement online bids are invited from reputed and experienced in any business contractors having minimum experience of two years with a **minimum average annual turnover of Rs.40 lakhs** during the two financial years 2021-22 & 2022-23 in any business.
3. Tender documents can also be downloaded from the web site **www.tgsrtc.telangana.gov.in**.
4. Tender document processing fee @ **Rs 5900/-** (single processing fee is enough for all regions) shall be paid in the form of Demand Draft obtained in favor of TELANGANA STATE ROAD TRANSPORT CORPORATION and the same shall be scanned and uploaded at the time of bid submission through online. The original DD shall be enclosed (submitted), at the time of submission of hard copies.
5. Earnest Money Deposit @ **Rs.3,00,000/-** (separately if participated for more than one region) shall be paid in the form of DD obtained in favour of TELANGANA STATE ROAD TRANSPORT CORPORATION and the same shall be scanned and uploaded at the time of bid submission through online. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE TENDER

General

1. All the tenderers including those who have downloaded the Tender Document are requested to get in touch with the Marketing & Commercial Department/TGSRTC for all updates on the tender such as addendums, replies to queries, postponement of tender schedules etc., or monitor the website for the same. No claims or compensation will be entertained on account of the Tenderer having not read/noticed the updates, etc.
2. Tenderer is required to read carefully the contents of this document and is expected to examine all instructions, forms, Terms and Conditions in the tender documents. Failure to furnish all information required as per the tender document or submission of a tender not substantially responsive to the tender documents in every respect will be at the Tenderer's risk and may result in rejection of the tender.
3. **The Tender must be submitted in the prescribed Tender Form along with requisite EMD and Tender document processing fee. Single tender document and Tender document fee is enough for one / more than one / all the Regions. However, the tenderer has to pay EMD amount for the stipulated amount separately for each of the Regions.**
4. The Tender form must be signed by the Tenderer (either individual or representing a firm) only.
5. The Tender once submitted shall not be permitted to be withdrawn. The Corporation shall not be responsible for the delay in finalizing the tenders - for administrative reasons or for the reasons beyond its control viz., Court directive etc.
6. Incomplete Tenders, Tenders not accompanied by Demand Draft for requisite EMD and DD for Tender document processing fee will be rejected. Cheques in lieu of Demand Drafts will not be accepted.
7. **Any person/agency/organization, who/which was an Contractor to the Corporation in the past and was terminated due to default in payment or for any other reason and any existing Contractor who defaulted in payment of contract amount equivalent to 6 months and above in the present contract on the date of submission of this tender, is disqualified from participating in this Tender.**

Earnest money Deposit

8. The EMD is **Rs.3,00,000/-**. Each Tender Form shall be accompanied by a Demand Draft obtained from any Nationalised Bank / Scheduled Bank for the stipulated amount towards EMD. No exemption of EMD is allowed to any Government Organisation/SSIs etc. The Demand Draft should be obtained in favour of TELANGANA STATE ROAD TRANSPORT CORPORATION, HYDERABAD. EMD in any other form other than Demand draft will not be accepted.

The tenderer shall also submit DD for an amount of Rs.5900/- towards Tender document processing fee.

9. The EMD will not carry any interest. The EMD of the unsuccessful tenderers will be refunded only after finalization of Tenders. The Corporation shall not be responsible for any delay in refund of EMD due to any reason in finalizing Tenders i.e. Administrative reasons / Court directive etc. The EMD of the successful tenderer will be adjusted towards Security Deposit payable to the Corporation.

10. The EMD of the tenderer will be forfeited under the following circumstances.

I. When the tender form submitted by the tenderer is invalid.

The Tender form is liable to be treated as invalid...

- (a) When the EMD is not paid or less than what is stipulated in the tender.

Eligibility Criteria

11. Only those tenderers who possess the following eligibility criteria shall apply. Tenderers shall submit documentary proof of eligibility criteria. Tenders which are not meeting the eligibility criteria will be summarily rejected.

The eligible tenderer can be an Individual/ Partnership firm/ Company/Corporation and shall fulfil the following criteria

- a) **Average Annual Turnover:** *The average annual turnover, in any business, of the tenderer for the two financial years 2022-23 & 2021-22 shall be **equal to or more than Rs 40 lakhs (as mentioned at Annexure-I).***

Proof of which shall be submitted by way of Audited Balance Sheet certified by authorized Chartered Accountant and Auditor's Certificate along with Profit & Loss Statements.

- b) **Experience:** The experience of the tenderer in any business field shall be for a minimum of **two years** in reputed public/private organizations.

The tenderer/firm should have completed two years of experience as on the date of submission of the tender.

The tenderer shall submit the proof of experience in the form of certificate (with details of period of experience and nature of work) issued by the concerned organization and shall be supported by copies of agreements.

- c) **Income tax:** *The tenderer shall submit income tax proof in the form of certified copies of Income Tax Returns filed for the two financial years 2021-22 & 2022-23 (as mentioned at Annexure-I).*

Submission of Tender:

12. Before submission of the tender, tenderers are required to make themselves fully conversant with the eligibility criteria and Terms and Conditions, so that no ambiguity arises at a later date in this respect.
13. If the tenderer finds discrepancies in tender document and its conditions or if he is in doubt as to their meaning he should at once intimate and obtain clarification prior to submission of the tender.
14. If the tender is submitted on behalf of a firm, name of the person representing the firm along with designation shall be mentioned in the tender form below the firm name. Also proof of authorization shall be enclosed.
15. If the tender is submitted on behalf of a firm, all documental evidences to be submitted in technical bid such as annual turnover, experience in the relevant field etc, shall be furnished only in the name of the firm with which the tender is submitted.

Signature of the tenderer.

16. The tender shall be filled in all respects and shall be signed by the Tenderer. The Tenderers should ensure that their offer is submitted on the **due date and time**. Offers received after due date and time, shall not be accepted.

Incomplete tenders or tenders not fulfilling any of the conditions specified above are liable to be rejected without assigning any reason.

17. Tenderer shall submit the tender **online**. The Tenderer shall submit their eligibility, qualification details, Technical bid, Commercial bid etc., in the online standard formats displayed in e-Procurement web site. The Tenderer shall upload the scanned copies of all the relevant certificates, documents etc., in support of their eligibility criteria/ certificates / documents in the e Procurement web site. The tenderer shall sign on the statements, documents, certificates, uploaded by them, owning responsibility for their correctness/authenticity.

Documents required for qualification:

- (a) Original Demand draft for Rs.5900/- towards Tender document processing fee (**single processing fee is enough for all regions**).
 - (b) Original DD for **Rs.3,00,000/-** towards the EMD (**separately if participated for more than one Region**).
 - (c) Application form duly filled and signed as at **Annexure I**.

19. The tender must be unconditional. Conditional offers will be summarily rejected. The tender shall be quoted by the Tenderer entirely in Indian Rupees.

Signature of the tenderer.

20. **The amount offered per region per month, in the commercial bid shall be for the first year of contract. The amount offered shall be the net amount payable to the Corporation. The contract amount offered per Region per month will be enhanced by 10% every year from 2nd year onwards over the contract amount payable in the previous year of contract.**

Opening and Evaluation of Bids:

21. The Tenders will be evaluated online in the Corporate Office, TGSRTC, Musheerabad, Hyderabad, at 3.00 P.M., on **04.11.2024** for technical evaluation and Price bids will be evaluated online on **06.11.2024**, at 12.00 P.M.

22. The following procedure will be adopted for evaluating of the tenders.

- i. **Technical Bid** will be evaluated to verify its contents and the supporting documents to ascertain the eligibility of the tenderers. The Technical bids will be scrutinized on the basis of basic eligibility criteria.

If the documents are incomplete or not in the prescribed formats or substantially insufficient to evaluate the eligibility criteria for short listing the Tenderer on the basis of the information contained in it may render the tender invalid and the tenderer will be disqualified for commercial bids. The EMD of the disqualified tenderer will be refunded. The applicant may collect the same from TGSRTC with due acknowledgement.

- ii. **Commercial Bid** will be evaluated, only of those Tenderers, who have fulfilled the requirements stipulated for the Technical Bid.

Note: Even though the tenderers meet the above eligibility criteria, they are subject to be disqualified if they have made misleading or false representations in the forms, statements and attachments submitted in proof of the eligibility requirements.

Evaluation of Commercial Bid.

23. The Bids will be evaluated mainly basing on the highest License fee offered for the region per month for the first year of contract and tender will be awarded to the tenderer whose offer is the highest, after negotiations and recommendations made by Tender Committee constituted for this purpose.

The amount quoted online will be the same for the 1st year of contract period. The contract amount will be enhanced by 10% from 2nd year onwards over the contract amount paid in previous year.

Tender Evaluation Committee

24. The Tender Evaluation Committee constituted by the TGSRTC shall evaluate the tenders. The decision of the Tender Evaluation Committee in the evaluation of the Technical and Commercial bids shall be final. No correspondence will be entertained outside the process of negotiation/ discussion with the Committee.

Signature of the tenderer.

25. Any approach from the tenderers representative or his/her agent trying to influence the decision on the tender, officially or otherwise, shall render the tender liable to be summarily rejected. The tender committee has been empowered to take the final decision regarding the tender.

Amendment of Tender Document:

26. At any time prior to the deadline for submission of proposals, TGSRTC may for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Tenderer modify the Tender Document by issuing an addendum.

Any Addendum thus issued shall become a part of the Tender Document and will be posted on the website www.tender.telangana.gov.in or www.tgsrtc.telangana.gov.in

To provide reasonable time to the prospective Tenderers to take an addendum into account while preparing their proposals, the deadline for submission of proposals may be extended, at the discretion of the tendering authority, if required.

Allotment of contract

27. The contract will be allotted to the highest tenderer, after negotiations and recommendations made by the Tender Committee. The successful tenderer shall enter into agreement within 15 days from the date of issue of letter of allotment of the Contract duly paying Security Deposit and furnishing Bank guarantee for the stipulated amounts.

Termination of tender process

28. TGSRTC may terminate the tender process at any time and without assigning any reason. TGSRTC makes no commitments, express or implied, that this process will result in a business transaction with anyone.

1. The contract is for appointment of Region wise Contractors for display of advertisements in the covered area of Bus stations (within the built up area – under the roof) of KRMR Regions for a period of five years
2. The list of bus stations is at Annexure-II (The tenderers may inspect the Bus stations physically to have a clear idea before submitting their tender).
3. The successful tenderer shall have to pay Security Deposit i.e., amount equivalent to six highest monthly installments of the contract amount within 15 days from the date of issue of allotment letter for the contract.

The Security Deposit shall be paid to the Director(TA & ZSTC) T.G.S.R.T.C., Musheerabad, HYD., through a Demand Draft obtained from any Nationalized Bank/Scheduled Bank located in Telangana in favour of TELANGANA STATE ROAD TRANSPORT CORPORATION, Musheerabad, HYD, payable at Hyderabad.

The Security Deposit will not carry any interest and will be refunded to the Contractor after one month from the date of completion of contract period, after adjusting the dues, if any payable by the Contractor to the Corporation.

The Security Deposit will not be adjusted towards monthly installments payable by the Contractor.

In case of termination of contract due to breach of Terms and Conditions of contract / agreement, corporation shall have the right to adjust the Security Deposit paid by the contractor towards the dues payable to the Corporation and to forfeit the balance Security Deposit.

4. The successful tenderer shall have to submit Bank guarantee for an amount equivalent to six monthly installments of 1st year of contract amount within 15 days from the date of issue of allotment letter of the contract. The Bank guarantee shall have validity for 12 months.

The Bank guarantee shall be furnished in addition to Security Deposit. **The Bank guarantee will be returned after completion of 12 months period.**

The Corporation shall have the right to invoke the Bank guarantee at any time and to adjust the realized amount towards the due amounts payable to the corporation, if the Contractor defaults in payment of monthly installment amount or penalty, or for breach of any Terms and Conditions of the agreement.

5. The successful tenderer shall enter into an agreement with the Corporation duly paying applicable stamp duty (@2% of average annual license fee) within 15 days from the date of issue of allotment letter for the contract.
6. Failure to pay Security Deposit and / or to furnish Bank guarantee / enter into an agreement within the stipulated period shall render cancellation of allotment of contract and the EMD / Security Deposit paid shall be liable for forfeiture.

Signature of the tenderer.

7. The following types of advertisements can be displayed in Bus stations (within the built up area-under the roof)

- Wall fixtures
- Backlit displays on walls around pillars
- Glow signs

8. PERMITTED

- a. The successful tenderer will be permitted to utilize 70% of the total space available for display of ads in Bus stations (within the built up area-under the roof)
- b. The successful tenderer will be permitted to utilize the space inside the Bus station only (within the built up area of the bus stations –upto commencement of platform).
- c. The successful tenderer can display advertisements within the covered/built up area of bus station without any hindrance to the movement of travelling public.

9. NOT PERMITTED

- d. the successful tenderer is not permitted to utilize space other than the covered area of the Bus stations for display of advertisements
- e. the successful tenderer is not permitted to utilize the space on terrace of the bus station.
- f. the successful tenderer is not permitted to utilize 30% of the space (within the built up area-under the roof) available in bus stations for display of advertisements.

10. The successful tenderer shall erect Glow sign boards at the platforms with details like, Platform number with indicated destinations etc., and also display the advertisements on the lower portion of these boards. In case the contractor is not willing to provide the same, Corporation reserves the right to give this work to the local advertisers on sponsorship basis.

11. The successful tenderer shall provide partition barricades (duly bearing its cost) with advertisements in consultation with the Unit Officer wherever it is required (i.e., at the entrance etc. within the built up area).

12. Corporation reserves the right to appoint separate Contractor / Contractors for display of advertisements in uncovered open space (from platforms to boundary wall of bus station premises, terrace of bus station buildings etc.) which are not covered under this contract).

13. Corporation is at liberty to display advertisements of its own or advertisements of Government Departments / Govt. sponsored advertisements/others in the 30% space within the built up area of the bus stations

Signature of the tenderer.

14. The contract amount payable by the Contractor shall be paid as under:

The amount as agreed to be paid to the Corporation for each month every year shall be paid **in advance** on or before 10th day of the month to the concerned AO / Dy CAO of ----- Region through demand draft obtained in favour of concerned AO / Dy CAO or through NEFT/ RTGS in which case UTR reference has to be submitted as proof of transfer of amount.

The Contractor shall pay the contract amount to the Corporation, without any deductions including TDS as corporation is exempted from Income Tax. In other words, the amount agreed to be paid to the Corporation towards the contract shall be paid in Toto.

In the event of delay in payment of monthly installment the Contractor is liable to pay **penalty** for each day of delay beyond the due date @ 36% per annum on the amount payable in addition to the installment amount. This clause shall not prevent the corporation from invoking Bank guarantee and adjusting the realized amount / Security Deposit amount of the Contractor..

15. The Contractor shall pay GST to the Corporation as per the rules in force and at the rate as fixed by the Government from time to time on the contract amount payable to the Corporation, in addition to payment of contract amount as agreed to be paid to the Corporation.

16. If the contractor fails to pay the monthly installments within stipulated period as per the terms & conditions of this agreement, or commits breach of any conditions of the agreement, the Corporation shall have the right to take any one or all the following actions:

- a. to order to stop display of advertisements.
- b. to invoke the Bank guarantee, and to adjust the amount towards due amounts payable to the corporation.
- c. to adjust the Security Deposit amount towards due amounts payable to the corporation
- d. to remove advertisements displayed.
- e. to terminate the contract.

In case contract is terminated, corporation shall have the right to adjust the deposits (Security Deposit and Bank guarantee amount) towards all the dues payable to the corporation including incidental financial losses that might arise on account of such premature termination and also to forfeit the balance of deposit amount.

17. The Contractor shall carry out the business of display of advertisements in the covered area of Bus stations for a **minimum period of one year from the date of commencement of the contract.**

In the event of the contractor seeking premature termination of contract within the stipulated one year period, the contractor has to pay the balance monthly installments for the left over period of minimum stipulated contract period.

If the contractor clears the balance contract amount for the left over minimum stipulated period of one year, the deposits (Security Deposit and Bank Guarantee) will be refunded. In case the contractor fails to pay the amount which falls short of the amount payable for one year, Corporation has the right to adjust the deposits paid by the contractor towards the dues payable by the contractor and to refund the balance deposits, if any. In the event of any further short fall even after adjustment

of Security Deposits, the contractor shall make good the short fall within the prescribed time.

18. The contract can be terminated by giving three months advance notice on either side.

But the contractor has to carry out the business for a minimum period of one year as per the Clause 17. If the contractor seeks premature termination, immediately on completion of one year, he/she has to intimate (in writing) his / her intention to terminate the contract at the beginning of the fourth quarter (i.e. soon after completion of 9 months period) from the date of commencement of the contract, in the form of 3 months advance notice.

However, Corporation reserves the right to terminate the contract any time during the contract period, by giving 3 months advance notice to the contractor.

In such circumstances, the deposits which may remain to the credit of the contractor will be refunded after all the dues payable to the corporation have been settled out of the deposits made by the Contractor (Security Deposit, Bank guarantee etc.). Corporation shall not be liable to pay any damages that the contractor may suffer on account of such termination.

In case of any violation / breach of Terms and Conditions of the contract, corporation reserves the right to terminate the contract with one Month advance notice besides forfeiture of Security Deposit and Bank guarantee amount.

19. The contractor shall bring all equipments and materials just before fixing / displaying advertisements in Bus stations, at their own cost. It is also the responsibility of the contractor to take away the advertising materials immediately after the fixing / display work is completed.

Under no circumstances, the Bus stations should be allowed to lose their identity in the process of display of advertisements.

20. i) The contractor shall have to obtain any certificate or permission or licence as may be necessary or required from the concerned authorities of Central Government / State Government / Local body for display of advertisements.

ii) The contractor shall comply with all the rules and procedures laid down in the local / within the territorial limits, in which the business is carried on and shall pay all the Taxes, Advt. fees or other sums payable to the local or any authorities for the purpose of carrying out the business of display of advertisements in covered Bus stations and there shall be no dues payable to any authority.

21. The Contractor shall in no manner evade any governmental responsibilities and obligations in terms of practicing of laid down norms for undertaking such business activities.

22. Corporation shall have the right to operate any Bus station or not to operate any Bus station depending upon its exigencies. The corporation at its discretion shall have the right to make use of the bus station for any other purpose – other than for the use of passengers / buses. The Contractor shall not have any right or objection in making use of the bus station for other purposes. If required, the Contractor has to remove the advertisements displayed in the bus stations, at their own cost. The Contractor shall not claim any charges for loss of his business on account of such removal of advertisements.

In case of demolition (part or full) of any Bus station during the subsistence period of the contract, the corporation shall not be liable for any loss or damage caused to the Contractor. The Contractor is not permitted to display any ads in the open premises which exist after demolition.

However, corporation will reduce licence fee proportionately for such of those Bus stations which are under the contract of the Advt. Contractor but subsequently demolished / used for other purposes during the subsistence of the agreement period.

23. The contractor shall not display advertisements of businesses competitors with TGSRTC in passenger transport and Cargo & Logistics, Tourism

24. The Contractor will not be allowed to display advertisements in the Bus stations other than those notified and allotted to the Advt. Contractor under the present contract. Advertisement rights on other / new Bus stations / expanded part of existing Bus stations will rest with the corporation.

25. The Contractor shall not undertake any advertisements for display in Bus stations which may offend decency, good morals or may promote ill will or hatred amongst any class or classes of the public. Corporation shall have the right to prohibit / reject such advertisements from display and the contractor shall not have the right to claim for any loss or damages that he may suffer on account of such rejection or restriction.

26. The contractor shall not display advertisements concerning to Tobacco, Liquor, Alcoholic products – Narcotics, Obscene material, Religious / Political and Election campaign slogans or any other product prohibited by the Corporation / Government from time to time.

27. The contractor shall obtain approval of the Unit Officer duly submitting a copy of the content of the advertisement to the concerned Unit Officer **and Regional Manager** specifying the subject matter of advertisement, periodicity and time (of display) of advertisement etc. before display.

The Unit Officer shall have the right to reject either whole or part of the Advertisement, if the advertisement is objectionable and against the interests of the corporation or the general public or not worthy for display.

No advertisement shall be displayed without prior approval of the Unit Officer concerned.

Even, where the advertisement is approved by the Unit Officer, the Regional Manager concerned and DIRECTOR(TA & ZSTC) at Corporate Office shall have the right either to reject the advertisement or to ask for modification, if in their opinion, the advertisement would be detrimental to the policy/interest of the Corporation/ Government/public interest.

28. The DIRECTOR (TA & ZSTC) / Regional Manager / Depot Manager / Assistant Traffic Manager concerned shall have the right of scrutiny of the advertisements displayed by the contractor and shall have the right to reject or modify either whole or part of the advertisement if the advertisement is detrimental to the policy / interest of the Corporation / Government / public interest.

29. The Corporation shall not be liable for any loss incurred by the Contractor to its Bankers, Financial institutions, customers, personnel engaged by the contractor or any other person connected with the business of the Contractor.
30. The Contractor:
- a) shall display Ads in covered premises of Bus stations duly defacing / removing the existing Ads, if any.
 - b) shall not accept any advertisements for display beyond the date of expiry of the agreement;
 - c) shall not resort to display of advertisements in Bus stations beyond the 70% space available for display of advertisements (within the built up area under the roof)
31. The Contractor is liable to ensure to remove / deface advertisements from the Boards (a) after expiry of the period of display of such advertisement (b) advertisements relating to Govt related Schemes on enforcement of the Model Code of Conduct, during the subsisting period of agreement.
- No display of any advertisement shall exist in any Bus station after completion of the contract period.
- In case the Contractor fails to remove the advertisements after completion of contract period or within seven days from the date of termination of contract for whatsoever reasons, the Contractor is liable to pay penalty at the rate of Rs.5000 (Rupees Five Thousand only) per day per Bus station, for displaying advertisements unauthorisedly.
- The Contractor shall reimburse the consequential expenditure involved in removing such advertisement material in case the Corporation removes the advertisements. The Corporation shall also have the right to adjust the deposits made by the Contractor towards the removal charges.
32. Advertisements by direct painting on the walls, pillars etc., will not be allowed under any circumstances.
33. The Contractor shall display Ads in covered areas of the Bus stations only with prior approval of the Regional Manager / Depot Manager / Assistant Traffic Manager of the Bus station concerned, in such a way that they shall not cause any hindrance to the working of the TGSRTC, Traffic movements and do not block and spoil the elevation of the Buildings, Civil structure and cause damage to the property of the Corporation.
34. The Contractor shall make arrangements to provide the requisite infrastructural facilities for display of advertisements in covered Bus stations, at their own cost. The Contractor shall also fix and remove the advertisements at their own cost.
35. The Contractor is liable for the damages caused to the Bus stations or to any property of the Corporation or to any person in the course of display of advertisements or in the course of removing advertisements.
36. The Contractor shall furnish information that may be required by the Corporation from time to time, connected with the display of advertisements in covered Bus stations.

Signature of the tenderer.

- 37.If the Contractor is found displaying advertisements unauthorizedly in Bus stations or commits any breach of Terms and Conditions of the agreement, a penalty up to a maximum of Rs.2000/- on each occasion will be imposed.
- 38.The Contractor shall have to pay the contract amount as agreed to be paid to the Corporation, irrespective of display of advertisements in covered Bus stations.
- 39.The Corporation shall not be accountable for any loss or damage or theft of equipment – accessories etc. that the contractor may suffer on account of any advertisements displayed or not displayed in Bus stations for any reason.
- 40.Corporation will arrange supply of Electricity to the Contractor in case of any need for display of advertisements in Bus stations. But the internal fittings and electrical sub – meter etc. shall be arranged by the Contractor at their own cost. The Contractor shall pay the electricity charges to the concerned Unit Officer as per the rates fixed by the Corporation from time to time on or before 10th day of every month. Delay in payment of electricity charges will attract penalty @ 36% per annum.
- 41.The Contractor shall not engage persons below the age of 18 years. The persons engaged by the Contractor shall not have any right or claim whatsoever, for employment in the Corporation at a future date.
- 42.The Contractor shall comply with the provisions of all the Acts of Government relating to Labour and the Rules and Regulations made there under, from time to time like payment of P.F., ESI, Minimum wages as prescribed by the State Government and submit the proof of compliance. The Contractor shall at all times indemnify the Corporation all claims, damages for compensation under the provisions of all Laws and Acts pertaining to the Labour engaged by it.
- 43.The Corporation is not liable to pay compensation in case of death or injury (simple / grievous) caused to any person engaged by the Contractor in connection with display of advertisements in covered Bus stations or in case of death or injury caused to any person / public due to fixation of hoardings / boards / display of advertisements. The Contractor is liable to bear all expenses and for payment of compensation in such cases.
- 44.The Contractor shall indemnify the Corporation for any claim made by any authority and reimburse the same in case any payments are made by the Corporation.
- 45.In case in any Bus station advertisements are not displayed due to electricity breakdown / bundhs / agitations / other internal or external factors, for a particular period or periods – the Corporation shall not be liable for any loss or damage caused to the Contractor.
- 46.The Contractor shall not appoint other firms / agencies / individuals as sub – Contractors to carry out the business of display of Advertisements in Bus stations.
- 47.The Contractor shall not employ, associate or include as business partner any person who was contractor of the Corporation and defaulted in payment of contract amount.

Signature of the tenderer

In case it comes to the notice of the Corporation that the Contractor has employed / associated / included such person in carrying out the business, the Corporation shall have the right to terminate the contract.

48. The business shall be carried out only on the name / firm, as the case may be, that was specified on the Tender form, while submitting the tender. During the course of contract, the Contractor/ Agency shall not be allowed to change the name of the Agency or to transfer the Agency.
49. The VC&MD of the Corporation reserves the right to accept, reject or modify any or all tenders without assigning any reasons thereof. The tenderer shall have no cause of action or claim against the Corporation for rejection of his / her tender.
50. The VC&MD of the Corporation reserves the right to modify any condition / conditions of the agreement, and add any other condition / conditions during the contract period. The Contractor has to abide by the conditions modified / incorporated and has to enter into a fresh agreement with the corporation at their cost.
51. In case of any dispute or differences arising on the Terms and Conditions of the tender or contract as the case may be, the decision of the VC&MD of the Corporation shall be final and binding on both the parties.
52. If any dispute arises between the Contractor and the Telangana State Road Transport Corporation, the Courts in Hyderabad and Secunderabad shall have jurisdiction.
