TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ALLOTMENT OF CONTRACTOR / AGENCY FOR PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT WORKERS ON OUTSOURCING, AT NEW &OLD BUS STAION KHAMMAM UNDER KHAMMAM DEPOT

- The Agency shall have to undertake the contract work of providing for Public announcement system at KHAMMAM NEW & OLD Bus station under the jurisdiction of KHAMAMM Depot. The prescribed duties and responsibilities of Public announcers engaged at Bus Stations are furnished at ANNEXURE to these terms and conditions.
- 2. The Man Power Agency has to furnish its Registration Number / Labour Licence Number and its validity obtained from Govt. of Telangana State only are eligible to participate in this tender to provide Traffic Guides/ Public Announcement Workers
- 3.a) The TSRTC Retired Employees registered Societies/Agencies and the Man Power Agencies/Contractor shall be in possession of individual Code No. of PF & ESI unless they are exempted. Other things being equal preference will be given to the APSRTC Retired Employees registered Societies/Agencies for allotment of contract.
- 3(b) Among the lowest bidders with the equal qualification, if no APSRTC Retired Employees Registered Societies are available, the contract shall be allotted on the basis of lottery.
- 4.a) The tender form is not transferable, i.e the person who purchases the tender form shall only participate in the tenders.
 - b) If the tender form is transferred, i.e the name of purchaser of the tender form and the participant differ, the tender has to be treated as invalid and rejected apart from forfeiture of EMD amount.
 - c) The Tenderer shall quote the notified contract value of the Tender Notification (i.e inclusive of statutory contributions of PF, EDLIF & ESI etc., along with administrative inspection charges wherever applicable, plus 7% profit margin.)
 - d) If any tenderer quotes less than the notified contract value, such a quote will be automatically disqualified and the Tender Committee shall not consider such a quote at any cost.
 - e) The priority in the allotment shall be given to the tenderer, who has been registered with Provident Fund and ESI authorities and having PF and ESI Code Numbers.
 - f) If there is more than one tenderer quoting the equal specified contract value, the allotment shall have to be made on the basis of the LOTTERY.
- 5) The contractor should be present at the work spot regularly.
- 6) Seperate Tender form shall be submitted for each depot.

- 7) The Tender forms duly filled in together with EMD D.D. shall be submitted in the tender box kept in the office of the Regional Manager, KHAMMAM at the time and date as per the schedule given in the Tender Notification. The sealed Tenders will be opened as per the schedule given in the Tender Notification in the presence of the Tenderers or their authorised representatives. Tender form not accompanied by D.D. towards EMD amount as indicated in the Tender Notification will be rejected.
- 8) The EMD prescribed should be paid through Demand Draft / crossed Cheque drawn in favour of ACCOUNTS OFFICER, "TSRTC" payable at KHAMMAM (from any Nationalized Banks only), and in case of failure to enclose the Demand Draft in original to the Tender form/Application will be rejected. The EMD amount shall not carry any interest. Payment of EMD in any other form will not be accepted.

The sealed cover should be placed in a tender box, kept in the office of the Regional Manager, Khammam at Old Bus station, Khammam from 10.30Hrs upto 14.00 hrs. on 25-02-2025. The tenders received after the stipulated date and time will not be accepted. Tenders will be opened at 15.00 hrs., on the same day by the Tender Committee at New Bus station, Khammam.

- 9) EMD is not exempted to any Society/ Voluntary Organisations/ Institutions/ Communities etc,.
- 10) In case Earnest Money Deposit paid by the Tenderer is less than what is stipulated in the Tender Notification or the EMD paid through other means i.e., in a manner other than the stipulated in terms and conditions, the tender will be rejected besides forfeiting the Earnest Money Deposit.
- 11) The Corporation is not responsible, if the tenders are held up due to litigation in Hon'ble Courts OR for any other administrative reasons.
- 12) The EMD amount of unsuccessful bidders will be refunded only after finalisation of Tenders, without any interest.
- 13) Tenders in the name of the minor or on behalf of the minors will be rejected. Tenders once made shall not be permitted to withdraw.
- 14) In case of Firms/Companies/Corporations etc., the authorised representatives can submit the tender application along with authorisation letter.
- 15) The contract is initially for a period of TWO (2) YEARS and extendable for one more year on similar terms and conditions subject to satisfactory performance.
- 16) The Contractor/Agency should deploy only male candidates for traffic guides and male or female for public announcement system.
- 17) The Contractor/Agency shall provide dress design to the staff as prescribed by the Corporation. All white with name badge.
- 18) Mike System should be used in Public Address System provided by TSRTC.
- 19) The Contractor has to install/maintain computers and other Equipment of his and at his own cost, if necessary.

- 20) Corporation will provide necessary space either to being utilized by TSRTC to arrange and to operate the Computers as well as for control charts for execution of contract as specified by the Corporation.
- 21) The Persons/Workers with required Computer Knowledge to be deployed for public announcement system.
- 22) Copy rights of the Software and reserved to the Licensor.
- 23) The Tender is for outsorcing Traffic guides and for public announcement and other related works at TSRTC, KHAMMAM NEW &OLD Bus station and for related reports round the clock including Sundays and Public Holidays i.e.,365 days in Bus Station Complex, KHAMMAM.
- 24) The persons engaged by the Contractor should be able to attend to the oral enquires from the passengers besides attending to Telephonic enquiries and giving recorded announcement as well as oral public announcement of the departure and arrival and other information including the marketing schemes introduced by TSRTC from time to time.
- 24) The contractor shall have to provide the necessary requirement related with the work entrusted and maintain the same or any other equipment for this purpose.
- 25) The contractor shall undertake to carry out the installations of necessary Mikes etc., and also to keep the personnel at the places of enquiry and others as indicated by the Station Manager/Depot Manager, KHAMMAM Depot.
- 26) The Corporation authorities, or any authority permitted by it shall have the right to inspect the functioning of the equipment provided and the performance of the workers engaged during the license period and issue such orders and directions as considered necessary to the contractor and the contractor shall ensure that such orders are compiled promptly.
- 27) The contractor shall bear the expenditure for maintaining the equipment and materials brought by him or TSRTC equipment material and ensure functioning without any break down. The stationery in standard form will be supplied by TSRTC like tickets, control charts etc.
- 28) The contractor shall be responsible to make good any loss or damages caused to the premises and property therein of the Corporation by the workers/employees of the contractor while rendering the said entrusted work. The Corporation shall have the right to recover such amounts towards damages caused from the Security Deposit of the contractor or recovery from monthly remuneration.
- 29) The contractor shall bear the cost of damages caused to the systems, appliances/instruments, if any related to the entrusted work provided by him/her TSRTC and in case of theft, he has to replace it with new one during the subsistence of the agreement period including the repair charges.
- 30) The persons to be employed by the contractor shall invariably possess the following qualifications to attend to the contracted works. They must be able to read, write and speak Telugu and English and shall be familiar with local geography and culture.

- The workers to be deployed for Passenger guides by the contractor must be above 18 years and below 62 years of age as on the date of filing tender provided they shall be physically fit. And for public announcement system the contractor should not engage persons below the age of 18 years and the above the 35 years of age for the work. At any cost child labour i.e., children below 18 years of age, should never be engaged for the contracted work.
- 32) Must produce a fitness certificate issued from SMO/MO of TSRTC Dispensaries once in a year with a cut of date on1st July.
- 33) The tender form duly filled in, along with the Demand Draft in original towards the EMD amount of rupees as mentioned in the Tender Notification should be enclosed along with the terms and conditions duly signed on each page. Amount quoted by tenderer towards monthly remuneration should be written in both figures and words clearly and other supporting certificates shall be kept in a sealed cover and sealed. In case of any corrections on the monthly rates quoted or any other corrections in the tender form, they should be attested by the tenderer, otherwise the tender will be rejected at the discretion of the Tender Committee. On the sealed cover, the nature of contract work, name and address of the tenderer shall be indicated.
- 34) Tender Forms not accompanied by the Demand Draft in Original towards the requisite EMD; incomplete filled in tender forms, failure to sign and failure to enclose terms and conditions will be rejected. Also, the successful tenderer has to submit a Solvency Certificate issued by the competent authority.
- 35) Tender forms with any pre-conditions or additional conditions other than the conditions prescribed by TSRTC will summarily be rejected.
- 36) If the successful tenderer fails to take up the work within the period specified in the allotment order, the EMD will be forfeited, duly canceling the allotment order.
- 37) The successful tenderer shall enter into an agreement for undertaking the above work on the prescribed terms and conditions.
- 38) The successful bidder to whom the contract will be allotted shall have to undertake the contract for a minimum period of TWO YEARS from the date of entering into an agreement. If he desires to discontinue the contract for whatsoever reasons, before completion of minimum period of TWO YEARS of the contract, Security Deposit will be forfeited in favour of the Corporation.
- 39) The contract shall be terminable with One month advance notice, due to Unsatisfactory performance, or breach of any terms and conditions of the Deed of Agreement, duly forfeiting the security deposit.
- 40) The successful tenderer (allottee) has to pay Security Deposit equivalent to (1) ONE Month's remuneration, in cash or Demand Draft payable in favour of Accounts Officer, TSRTC, KHAMMAM Region and enter into an agreement with the RM/KHAMMAM failing which allotment is liable for cancellation and the EMD paid by him/her shall be forfeited to the Corporation without any further notice/intimation. Security Deposit will not carry any interest.
- 41) The remuneration will be paid to the successful bidder every month by the Corporation.

- 42)(a) The successful Contractor/Agency has to furnish the passport size photographs of the Traffic Guides and Public announcers to be deployed by him for contracted work, within 15 days of awarding contract containing the Name, Qualification, experience, age, Father's name, residential address of each Traffic Guide along with Tender Application. The Contractor shall not change the men without prior approval of the Depot Manager.
 - (b) The successful Contractor/Agency must maintain T & P handing over and taking over i.e. Mobile phones, Registers etc., with Corporation and also between their Traffic Guides and Public announcers.
 - (c) Any paid phone calls/SMSs made from the CUG Members will be educated from the successful Contractor/Agency. The repairs to the mobiles, replacement of mobiles etc., are to be borne by the Contractor/Agency. Mis-use of SIM cards either by the Traffic Guides/Contractor will be viewed seriously by the Corporation and action will be taken on the Contractor for any misuse of SIM Cards.
- 43) The contractor has to pay the minimum wage to the Traffic Guides and Public announcers as prescribed by the Govt. of T.S. from time to time, besides paying employer's contributions towards PF, EDLIF and ESI etc. in respect of the workers.
- 44) The contractor is liable for any obligation arising out of his contract in respect of labour engaged by him.
- 45) The contractor should deploy the no. of Traffic Guides and Public announcers prescribed against each shift, irrespective of his obligation to extend weekly rest to his workmen, which he has to meet on his own arrangement. The Traffic Guides have to strictly follow the shift timings allotted to them by the Traffic In-charge. The Traffic In-charge is authorized to change their shift duties based on the day to day traffic need.
- 46) The In-charge supervisors shall maintain Registers regarding Attendance and works carried out by the Traffic Guides and Public announcers engaged by the Contractor.
- 47) The In-charge supervisor shall certify the claim submitted by the contractor with reference to the Register maintained.
- 48) In case the Contractor deploys any of his family member who are covered under the term "Family Members" as defined under Sub-Section 3 of Section 26 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948, an Affidavit explaining the relationship and dependency shall be submitted, both by the Contractor as well as the reported family member of the Contractor individually.
- 49) The Successful Contractor should produce the Traffic Guides and Public announcers, whom he proposes to deploy against the work, along with their certificates concerned, before the Tender Committee on finalization of the Tender.
- 50) The Contractor has to supply Two sets of White Colour Uniform per year, P'Cap, Whistle, Stick and Identity Name Plate shall be supplied to each Traffic Guide by the Contractor.

- 51) If any Public Announcement Workers /Traffic Guide of Contractor absents on a particular day, the corresponding amount has to be deducted from the monthly remuneration payable to Contractor.
- 52) In the event of the Contractor continuously defaulting and not supplying sufficient number of assigned Traffic Guides and Public announcers regularly, the Regional Manager on the recommendations of DM can terminate the contract with a month's notice.
- 53) The interested parties may inspect the premises of contract before submitting the tender form.
- 54) Tender forms with any pre-conditions or additional conditions other than the conditions prescribed by TSRTC will summarily be rejected.
- 55) If the successful tenderer fails to take up the work within the period specified, the EMD will be forfeited.
- 56) The successful tenderer shall enter into an agreement for undertaking the work on prescribed terms and conditions.
- 57) The monthly remuneration will be paid to the successful bidder every month by the Corporation.
- 58) No compensation shall be paid by the Corporation for any injury or death of the workers engaged by the Contractor within the premises of the contract area. The contractor is liable to bear all expenses and compensation in such cases. The contractor shall satisfy the TELENGANA STATE ROAD TRANSPORT CORPORATION with regard to the arrangements made by him to fulfill his obligations arising out of this clause by way of an Insurance Policy.
- 59) In case the Contractor, who is not in possession of PF and ESI Code Nos., the monthly bill of contract amount shall be paid to him only after deductions of the PF amounts from the wages of the persons engaged by him and recovering the matching contributions (Employer's share), together with administrative and inspection charges, EDLIF, ESI and any other recoveries that are to be made either from the persons engaged by him or from the Contractor at the rates prescribed from time to time as per the instructions issued in this matter.
- 60) In case of the contractor who is in a possession of individual PF/ESI Code Nos. obtained from the competent authority, the contractor shall remit the PF/EDLIF amounts in respect of the persons engaged by him, to the appropriate authorities under PF and ESI concerned on the code No. obtained by him and produce proof of the same every month to the Unit Officer to arrange payment of the monthly remuneration.
- 61) The Contractor has to contact the Labour Department and maintain the registers as required by the Corporation and the same have to be produced for verification of the inspecting officials.

- 62) The Contractor has to obtain licence from the Licensing Officer under Contract Labour (R&A) Act, 1970 to carry out the work contract in question in the contract area in the establishment of TSRTC and submit a copy of the same to the licensor and to the Depot Manager concerned before commencement of the Contract.
- 63) The Contractor has to comply with all the provisions of the Acts of Government relating to Labour Rules and Regulations made there-under from time to time, like payment of Minimum Wages, Provident Fund, EDLIF, ESI, weekly off etc., as prescribed by the State Government from time to time and submit the proof of compliance along with the Monthly bill to the Depot Manager concerned for payment. He has to indemnify the Corporation all the claims, damages for compensation under the provisions of all Laws and Acts pertaining to the Labour.
- 64) The Security Deposit is refundable on the expiry of the period of contract without interest and subject to the performance and fulfillment of agreement conditions.
- (a) The Security Deposit paid by the Contractor is liable to be forfeited in the event of non-commencement of maintenance work/service contract after depositing Security Deposit within the stipulated time as per the allotment order or breach of any of the terms and conditions of the tender form besides termination of contract.
 - (b) The Security Deposit amount is liable to be forfeited in the event of non-submission of Deed of Licence after payment of the Security Deposit amount and commencement of service contract.
- 66) The Security Deposit is liable to be forfeited in case the contractor fails to execute the contract for the period agreed to undertake the contract.
- 67) The monthly bill of the contract shall be paid to the Contractor only after submission of proof about deductions of the PF amounts from wages of the persons engaged by the Contractor and recovering the matching contribution (employer's EDLIF, ESI) and any other recoveries that are to be made from the persons engaged by the contractor at the rates prescribed from time to time and its remittance to the concerned authorities.
- 68) The contractor shall remit the PF deductions to the respective RPFC under intimation to the Depot Manager and he need not remit the PF deductions to TSRTC PF Trust. Similarly, the contractor should remit the ESI contributions to the authorities concerned under intimation to Corporation. Preference will be given to the tenderer possessing Licence obtained from the Labour Dept., Code Nos. allotted by the RPFC and ESI.
- 69) The contractor has to produce a certificate about his performance every month on or before 5th of succeeding month from the concerned authority on the satisfactory performance of the work to the concerned Unit Officer for arranging payment of monthly remuneration which will normally be arranged before 10th of succeeding month.

- 70) The contractor shall ensure deduction of PF contributions from the wages of the persons engaged by him together with the matching contribution of the employer (contractor) along with the Administrative and Inspection charges at the rates prescribed by the Government from time to time and remit to the Secretary, TSRTC PF (Trust), Hyderabad. If the tenderer is in possession of the Code No. allotted by the Regional Provident Fund Commissioner, he shall remit the PF deductions to the respective RPFC under intimation to the Licensor and he need not remit the PF deductions to TSRTC PF Trust. Similarly, the contractor should remit the ESI contributions to the concerned Authorities under intimation to Corporation. Preference will be given to the tenderer possessing License obtained from the Labour Dept. Code No. allotted by the RPFC & ESI.
- 71) The contractor shall insure the lives of the Labour engaged by him for any eventual risks that might crop up in the event of any accident and it shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor to meet all the claims/compensation for disability or loss of life of the labour and damage to the equipment pertaining to TSRTC if any.
- 72) The contractor is liable for imposition of penalties upto Rs.500/-, in each occasion, in case of complaints from the Staff, Officers and Public on maintenance of the work and the same will be deducted from the monthly bills remuneration or the Security Deposit, as the case may be. In case, the amount is deducted from the Security Deposit, the contractor is liable to recoup the same immediately. Otherwise, the Contract is liable for termination duly forfeiting the Security Deposit. This clause does not stand as a bar for implementing the clause of "termination of contract for improper maintenance".
- 73) The rights given under this contract are not transferable.
- 74) The contract is not permitted to sub-let the contract work to any other sub-contractor.
- 75) In case of misbehavior, assault on employees of the Telangana State Road Transport Corporation by the contractor or his representatives /workers will lead to imposition of penalty or termination of contract duly forfeiting the Security Deposit.
- 76) The Management reserves right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason thereof. The Management also reserves the right to allot the contract to any person of its choice through negotiations with the tenderers after justifying their ability to comply with the Labour Laws viz., Payment of Minimum Wages recovery and remittance of contributions towards PF/EDLIF/ESI etc,.
- 77) On the expiry of the period of contract or on its termination, as the case may be the contractor shall hand over the equipments if any to the Depot Manager of the concerned Depot duly handing over the contract.
- 78) (a)The contractor shall pay all the taxes (i.e., IT Tax, VAT/any of Govt. of TS) under the Central and State Acts/Rules made there under, applicable to the business. The Corporation is not liable for the penalties in view of nonpayment of taxes or default therein. Any default, nonpayment of taxes to statutory authorities will cause termination of contract and vacation of premises.
 - (b) GST: The payments if any on either side will be made under GST Act.

- 79) The contractor shall make his own arrangements for the materials requires for the purpose of carrying out the work. The list of materials minimum required monthly will be furnished by the Depot Manager and the contractor shall arrange to procure the required materials for one month in advance and keep with the Depot Manager for verification. The quantity of materials may increase as per the site condition for which no extra payment will be made by the Corporation.
- 80) The tender committee reserves the right to alter/modify the period of contract mentioned in the Tender Notice at the time of finalization of Tender.
- 81) Income Tax as per the provisions of I.T. Act and other taxes if any will be recovered from the monthly payment and the contractor has to obtain the PAN Number from the Income Tax Department and the same is to be produced.
- 82) All the tools, materials etc., required to carry out the above works are to be brought and minor repairs if any will be carried out by the Contractor himself.
- 83) The contractor and the persons engaged by him for the work are subjected to security check while incoming and outgoing of the Depot premises.
- 84) Any violation or breach of terms and conditions of the contract including unsatisfactory maintenance of contract work shall render the contract liable to be terminated duly forfeiting the security deposit.
- 85) The Corporation shall have right to terminate the contract with a month's notice if in its opinion the work of contract is not satisfactory and its decision in this regard shall be final.
- 86) The workers employed by the Contractor / the Contractor himself shall not have any right or claim whatsoever for employment in the Telangana State Road Transport Corporation at a future date.
- 87) The Contractor should adhere to all acts and laws enforce applicable to his business and for any violation of such laws the sole responsibility lies with the Contractor.
- 88) In the event of any statutory authority imposing any punishment like fines etc., and if the Corporation is made a Party in such penal action, the Corporation has got the authority to keep and recover such amount due to contractor like remuneration, security deposit etc., with it until it is proved to the satisfaction of the Corporation that such penal actions are ceased. Such actions may also be reason for termination of contract.
- 89) On the expiry of the period of licence or on its termination as the case may be the Contractor shall handover the equipments supplied by department if any to the Unit Officer concerned in good working condition.
- 90) The successful Tenderer / Agency has to furnish the passport size photographs of the workers to be deployed by him for the contracted work within 15 days of awarding contract containing the name, qualification, experience, age, Father's name, residential address of each worker along with tender application. The Contractor shall not change the work when specified without prior approval of DM/ Maintenance Incharge.

- 91) The contractor should deploy the number of workers prescribed against each shift irrespective of his obligation to extend weekly rest to his workmen, which he has to meet on his own arrangement. The workmen have to strictly follow the shift timings allotted to them by the maintenance incharge. The maintenance incharge is authorized to change their shift duties based on the day to day requirement of men.
- 92) Other things / conditions being equal, the priority in the allotment shall be given to the "LOWEST TENDERER" (i.e., who quotes the remuneration not less than the floor rate as prescribed in the Tender Notice) who has been registered with Provident Fund and ESI authorities and having PF and ESI Code numbers.
- 93) In case, there are more than one Tenderer quoting the same lowest amount, allotment of contract shall be made on the basis of LOTTERY.
- 94) If any worker of Contractor absents on a particular day, the corresponding amount has to be deducted from the Contractor and such money can be utilized by Depot Manager to engage a Daily Wage Labour from the market and complete the work.
- 95) In the event of the Contractor continuously defaulting and not supplying sufficient no. of assigned men regularly, the DM on the recommendations of RM can terminate the contract with a month's notice.
- 96) The experience certificate or any other supporting documents found to be fake or non-genuine the allotted contract will be terminated and the EMD/SD paid by the contractor's will be forfeited besides placing him under the black list.
- 97) The contractor shall not engage any person whose character and credentials and integrating are doubtful in nature and those who are on the record of police with criminal background. If any such persons are engaged the contract is solely responsible for such engagement and he is responsible for all the consequences that may take place during the tenure of the contract.
- 98) In all disputes in case of doubts or interpretation of clauses or conditions and applications of this contract or otherwise, the decision of the MD, TSRTC shall be final.
- 99) All the above terms and conditions will form part of the agreement of the contract and the Contractor will be bound by the conditions in addition to any other conditions prescribed by the Corporation.
